NYSDOH Updated DSRIP Timeline

The State has delayed valuation due to network issues with one PPS that could have a state-wide impact. We now expect to learn our valuation and receive our award letter on May 7th. The first payment is also delayed and is now expected on May 28th. The amount of the first payment has now been increased to 60% of total Year 1 payments.



Additionally, the Implementation Plan submission deadline has been pushed from May 1st to June 1st.
